



NODES - Roles in new market design






Grid Location – a collection of meter point IDs


- **Connect Location**

Physical topology is not stored in NODES






Trading Timeline – Physical Products

Strategic challenges

Regulatory

- DSO able to purchase flexibility (i.e. a participant in NODES marketplace)
- Opex to be treated equally to Capex
- Grid tariffs must allow up regulation without penalising consumer

Technology

- The right horizon (availability vs flexibility contracts) in market design
