

Aduriz Launches Ultra-Fast EV Charging Station in Rural Northern Spain

GEODE member, <u>Aduriz Energía</u>, has reached an exciting new milestone in electric mobility with the <u>inauguration of its first ultra-fast EV charging station</u> in the north of <u>Burgos</u> province, marking a breakthrough for sustainable transport infrastructure in remote areas.

Located in the Villasante industrial estate (Merindad de Montija), a municipality with fewer than 1,000 residents and situated away from major highways, this station is a first of its kind in Castilla y León. It features a 180 kW ultra-fast charger, capable of fully charging an electric vehicle in just 20 minutes, alongside a 50 kW fast charger supporting multiple plug types including CHAdeMO, CCS, and Type 2.

The official launch event brought together local stakeholders, including the mayor of Merindad de Montija and representatives from EVsare, the developer of the Aduriz Recarga mobile app. This pioneering installation was made possible through funding from the European Union's NextGenerationEU programme, under the MOVES III plan by Spain's Ministry for the Ecological Transition and the Demographic Challenge. It forms part of the broader Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan, reinforcing the EU's vision of a greener, more connected future.

With this initiative, Aduriz sets a powerful example for how clean energy infrastructure can, and should, reach even the most rural corners of Europe.
